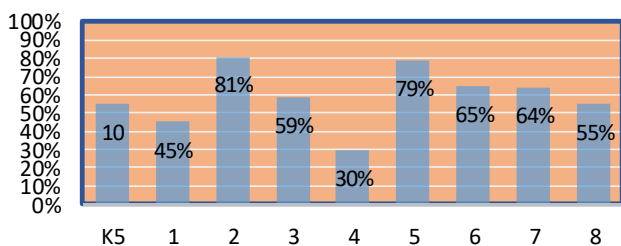
Due to the high amount of snow days this year we will now have school on **Monday, April 22<sup>nd</sup>**.
