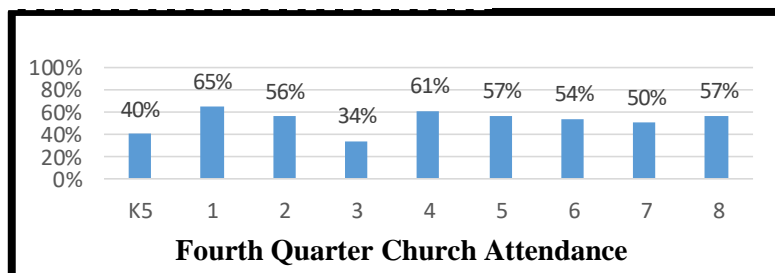

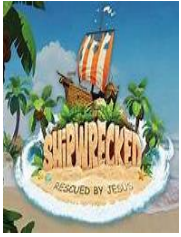

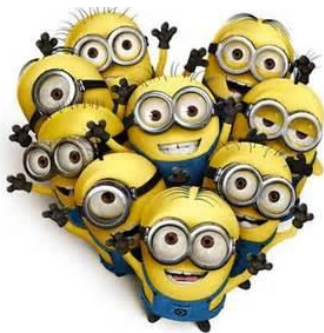

**School Choice Wisconsin** is being considered at St. Peter's for the 2019 - 2020 school year. A final decision will be made in the fall, but now we are collecting information. Unfortunately, students currently attending parochial schools are not eligible. Students from public schools or students entering 4K are eligible. The School Board and/or Mr. Winkler would like to meet with any interested family. The key financial requirement is that the family's gross adjusted income (Form 1040 line 37) needs to be met. For example, the GAI for a family of 4 to qualify in 2018-2019 is \$61,120. Please contact Mr. Winkler if you would like more information.
