The Youth Group and

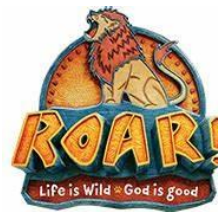
Fellowship Committee are planning a fun-filled family night as a fundraiser for our Youth Group. But we are in need of your help.
