### Hot Lunch:

**NOW - June 30, 2020**

All lunches and milk will be free for all students as the Free Lunch Program has been approved to continue through June, 30, 2020.

- Due to the difference in school schedules we may have some day where we will need to charge for lunch if you do our own lunch as there will be no school days for the Jefferson Public School (who is providing our free lunches) so on these days we will still offer lunches but it will be for the price of **\$2.50 per lunch w/ milk**. We will still honor the free/reduced pricing for those who qualify.

- There will now be **NO** charge for lunches on Oct. 29 & Oct. 30
